

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

HTS offers 3 pathways designed based on our licensed Ontario Curriculum and the Vietnamese Curriculum (MOET)

This ensures that every student receives a world-class education while maintaining eligibility for the Vietnamese High School Diploma. This dual approach safeguards the long-term interests of students living and working in Vietnam, equipping them with both international credentials and the recognition necessary to thrive locally.





ONTARIO OPTIMIZED PROGRAM (OOP)

Objectives: Students graduate with the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) to pursue studies at international colleges and universities or international institutions in Vietnam.

Availability: Grades 1-12

Key Highlight

- Students have the opportunity to graduate with the prestigious OSSD, a globally recognized qualification equivalent to IB, A-levels, or AP certifications.
- The licensed Ontario Curriculum, taught to native Canadian students, ensures seamless transferability to schools abroad.
- English is used as the primary medium for thinking and learning, rather than merely being taught as a language, fostering future success in international education pathways.
- In high school, students can choose from 3 specialized academic pathways International Business, Scientific Foundations, or World Perspectives – as a foundation for selecting their majors in university.




ONTARIO MOET PROGRAM (OMP)

Objectives: Students graduate with a Vietnamese High School Diploma and participate in international certification exams (IELTS, SAT) to pursue studies at international or domestic international colleges and universities.

Availability: Grades 10–12

- 35% of classes conducted in English, with up to 60% taught by expat teachers
- Prepare for international certifications such as IELTS and SAT during the course, supporting university entrance exams and admission.
- Personalized learning approach with enrichment sessions and competency assessment exam preparation
- Clear and structured guidance on selecting the appropriate academic stream and elective subject groups to optimize the chances of university admission.



ONTARIO INTEGRATED PROGRAM (OIP)

Objectives: Students graduate with dual diplomas: the Vietnamese High School Diploma and the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), and participate in international certification exams (IELTS, SAT) to pursue studies at international or domestic international colleges and universities.

Vietnamese subjects

- Hanoi Toronto School is one of the few institutions licensed to offer an integrated program. Overlapping subjects between the Ontario and MOET curricula are streamlined to reduce academic pressure while ensuring the requirements for both diplomas are fully met.
- Similar to the OOP pathway, students study the licensed Ontario Curriculum and have the opportunity to graduate with the globally recognized OSSD. This creates a strong foundation for pursuing international studies or transferring to schools abroad.
- Recognized by variety of Vietnamese Universities including British University Vietnam (BUV), Phenikaa University, and the National Economics University (NEU)
